A MESSAGE FROM THE ELDERS:

Today's message is for young men and women, who are such a blessing to those of us who are older. King David, throughout his life, wrote extensively about his relationship with God, giving us many Psalms in the process. Most of these are David's prayers and musings about God, written at various times throughout his life. As an old man, he wrote Ps 37, giving sage advice to the young:

- "Do not fret because of evil men..." [Note, this includes women also, but the Bible was written during a time when men dominated society]
- "Delight yourself in the LORD..."
- "Refrain from anger and turn from wrath..."

In Ps 119, he marveled and reflected on the perfection of God's Law, which we know today as the Bible - a truly miraculous book, full of wisdom from God which never runs out. In it, you can always find something to help with your situation - whatever that situation might be. Can you picture David reflecting on this when, as a shepherd boy, he thought:

"How can a young man keep his way pure? By living according to your word. I seek you with all my heart; do not let me stray from your commands. I have hidden your word in my heart that I might not sin against you." (Ps 119:9-11)

And that brings us to the point. God has spoken! How should we then live? "according to your word". His commands are given for our protection and benefit. To the young, they are given to you - so that you can become all that you can be! Therefore, may you say with David, "do not let me stray from your commands." And finally, to live this way his commands must be "in my heart". They must become a part of you and me. So, memorize them. When you're reading your Bible and you come across something that strikes you, memorize the passage. Get some note cards; write these passages down. Then, in your free time, work on memorizing them, instead of clicking on the latest social media posts (which are a huge distraction). When you're old, you'll be able to say with David (and with us): "I was young and now I am old, yet I have never seen the righteous forsaken or their children begging bread." (Ps 37:25)



This week's message is from Dale Lingey of Churches of Christ Disaster Relief, Inc. who sent a text with the information below directly from the Disaster Relief website this week. He has tasked us with writing short messages on pre-printed

templates for the Bibles they hand out with much needed supplies to the victims. Please grab some of the empty note templates on the visitor cart in the back of the auditorium and write a quick message to encourage the victims, encouraging one another, "While it is still called today" (Hebrews 3:13).

Semi-trailer Load of Supplies Unloaded in Brookhaven, Mississippi

This afternoon, one of our 53' trailers full of supplies was unloaded at the Mt Zion Church of Christ, in Brookhaven, MS. Several other congregations in the area will be working with the Mt. Zion to distribute the supplies to families affected by the tornadoes.

On the evening of May 6th, a reported 1,000 buildings, including approximately 500 homes were damaged or destroyed by 7 tornadoes across central and west Mississippi in Franklin, Lamar, Lawrence.
