A MESSAGE FROM THE ELDERS:

"I respect the one who takes advantage of the opportunities he is given", said my dad in response to my observation. We were discussing whether I would remain in school after having completed two years in college. I was considering not continuing and, in response to strong objections, had suggested that he should respect people in all kinds of professions – not just college-educated ones. His point was well-taken however and I did ultimately continue. Years later I thanked him for guiding me – in this and many other ways.

The Bible tells us that we are "created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do" (Eph 2:10). These good works should be seen as opportunities. They should be looked for, sought after, and once discovered should not be ignored, because they may never be repeated. Do you have an opportunity to share your faith today? Do it! Or perhaps, to help someone in need; or to visit and pray with them; or to read the Bible to your children/ grandchildren; or to turn the other cheek; or to demonstrate unusual patience; or to bear up under unjust suffering; or to develop and use your unique talents and situations to glorify God? All these good works, and many more, are already prepared for you. They are simply waiting for you to discover them – and do them.

Reflecting back, I appreciate my dad's wisdom. I thought I would always have the opportunity to go back to school if I wanted. But he knew and appreciated the truth in the saying that opportunity often knocks but once. In a similar way, the Bible is full of examples of those who missed it, not appreciating the incredible opportunities God had given them – Esau, King Saul, Judas. These all lived to regret their short-sightedness. Do not be like them. God has prepared good works FOR YOU. Now walk in them!
