## A MESSAGE FROM THE ELDERS:

Did you know that in 1777, during the Revolutionary War, the need for Bibles in America was so great that Congress ordered the importation of 20,000 Bibles "from Holland, Scotland, or elsewhere, into the different parts of the States of the Union." Until that time, virtually all the Bibles in America had been imported from England. But Britain cut off that supply during the Revolution, creating a crisis. The reliance of the American people on the Bible was so great that Congress had to respond – and they did.

Later, in 1781, near the end of the Revolution, Robert Aitken, A Philadelphia publisher and bookseller, petitioned Congress to support his plans to print a Bible in English – the very first Bible to be printed in America. Congress approved the petition and endorsed Aitken's Bible when it was completed in 1782. Today, the Aitken Bible is known by many as "the Bible of the Revolution."

Today we have many Bibles available to us and supply is no longer an issue. Today the need is for people to read, reflect on, and apply it. For us, who have dedicated our lives to Christ, these Bibles must form, as they did for nearly all early Americans, the base of our devotion, education, and views on all things. And for our country that we love, may she once again embrace the truth that sets us free – a truth found only in scripture.

"...Jesus said, 'If you hold to my teaching, you are really my disciples. Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free.'" (Jn 8:31)
