A MESSAGE FROM THE ELDERS:

The Shepherds' Corners for the month of June will focus on the subject of prayer. Prayer is simultaneously the most powerful and submissive act in our spiritual walk. Missions

What a great meeting we had with Carola last Wednesday night discovering more about the mission work we are partnering with in Mexico City with the church there. Here are some of the facts that were gathered.

- Activities: small groups every day of the week with 30-40 attendees that include; English classes, counseling women at the building, /meals for hospital visitors, visiting and helping at the children's home with tutoring the children and more
- Needs include: encouragement, painting & roofing building, baking classes, create garden space, leadership/mentorship resources & salary, financial support
- Current supporters: AIMER's (3 groups of 20), Sunset Bible Institute
- Conditions: Safest place in Mexico due to tourism
- Proposed mission trip schedule: AM devo, work, eat, tour, visit various works (small groups, hospital meal preparation/outreach, English classes, church services and potluck)
- Transportation: Metro, bus, walk
- Prerequisites: Must be in good physical condition as walking is extensive
- Weather: Rainy May-November
- Planning strategy: Notify church 1 year ahead of mission trip (for busy summer months), popular months are May & June
- Next steps: Possible scouting trip at the beginning of August
