A MESSAGE FROM THE ELDERS:

Last week we discussed rote prayer (a prayer read or recited from memory). At some point in our relationship with God, we realize that rote prayers are no longer enough. We feel the need to talk to God not talk at Him. We have things of our own we want to say and so we develop a more conversational approach to God. This makes up the majority of the mature Christian's prayer life. Our prayers have become more than just requests of God our prayers now include more discussion with the Creator.

When you are in private prayer, how do you pray? Do you pray out loud or in verbal silence?

Do you pray in words, thoughts or both? Read John 17, Jesus's prayer in the garden; notice how He prays to the Father.

This week we will also discuss a third way of praying which is learning to listen to God. Listening prayer is largely going to be done with the engagement of scripture. When we read scripture, do we really listen to God? Do we read scripture like we are driving an interstate highway, speeding to our destination or do we read it like driving an old country road trying to see all that is there? We all need to slow down and let God. A way to better listen to God is to read a portion of text, pray on what you just read, and then go back and reread making yourself receptive to what the Holy Spirit is telling you.

If you desire someone to pray with or need help getting started, any one of us are always happy to pray with you as is our prayer team. All we ask is that you let us know.
