## A MESSAGE FROM THE ELDERS:

Praise and Worship

Throughout scripture, the topics of Praise and Worship are so prevalent as to be synonymous with most, if not all, discussion regarding one's response to the Gospel message. Below are just a few examples taken from just one book of the Bible.

**Psalm 96:9** Worship the Lord in the splendor of his holiness; tremble before him, all the earth.

**Psalm 7:17** I will give thanks to the Lord because of his righteousness; I will sing the praises of the name of the Lord Most High.

**Psalm 100:2** Worship the Lord with gladness; come before him with joyful songs.

**Psalm 9:11** Sing the praises of the Lord, enthroned in Zion; proclaim among the nations what he has done.

**Psalm 95:6** Come, let us bow down in worship, let us kneel before the Lord our Maker

**Psalm 28:7** The Lord is my strength and my shield; my heart trusts in him, and he helps me. My heart leaps for joy, and with my song I praise him.

**Psalm 29:2** Ascribe to the Lord the glory due his name; worship the Lord in the splendor of his holiness.

Praise and worship clearly go hand in hand. Both are fitting responses to God and appear throughout Scripture as central expressions of faith. Yet these examples also show an important distinction between the two: *Praise* is the joyful outpouring of appreciation, gratitude, and adoration toward God. *Worship* is a humble response to God's supreme holiness and authority, leading us to deliberate devotion rather than self-exaltation. In this way, praise gives voice to our delight in God, while worship bows the heart before Him in reverence and surrender.
