A MESSAGE FROM THE ELDERS:

On the first missionary journey, the Holy Spirit sent Paul and Barnabus to many cities in the southern regions of Asia Minor (The Roman province of Galatia):

- At Pisidian Antioch, the people listened intently to their message. But when the whole town turned out to hear them, the Jews became jealous and opposed them.
- Again, at Iconium, many Jews and Gentiles believed the message, until some Jews hatched a plot to mistreat and stone the apostles. But they found out about it and left the city.
- In Lystra, the people were so impressed by a miraculous healing that they wanted to worship Paul and Barnabus as gods. But when some Jews came from Antioch and Iconium, they stirred up a crowd, who stoned Paul.

Through all of this, the apostles continued to tell people the good news – that in Jesus, God has come to earth to rescue his children, who we all are. They were not discouraged at all by this opposition. In fact, Paul later wrote to Timothy about it and said:
“You...know...what kinds of things happened to me in Antioch, Iconium and Lystra, the persecutions I endured. Yet the Lord rescued me from all of them. In fact, everyone who wants to live a godly life in Christ Jesus will be persecuted...” (2 Ti 3:10-12)

And this passage speaks to us. The man or woman who walks with Christ will, at times, find themself at odds with the people around them, through no fault of their own. At such times, make sure the fault does not lie with you; then remember that God has given us the same tools as he gave to the apostles to help us endure: The Holy Spirit to guide us; The Bible to instruct us; Christian companions to encourage us and to share our burdens with. So, if you suffer contempt, ostracism, criticism, insults, or rejections because of your faith in Christ, you're in good company. As Paul said, “Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up.” (Gal 6:9).
