A MESSAGE FROM THE ELDERS:

Years ago, I helped to manage building construction and would often have to solve problems related to design errors – the architectural plans conflicted with the structural plans; a pipe and a beam were shown in the same location; that kind of thing. At that time, the General Contractor would document the issue and bring it to our office for resolution. At times the sheer volume of these problems was overwhelming, and we started asking the contractor to stop bringing us problems alone – but also his proposed solution. That made a big difference in how quickly and efficiently we were able to respond.

In a similar way, Paul's 2nd missionary journey was his own idea (Acts 15:36). It did not begin, as the 1st journey had, at the command of the Holy Spirit (Acts 13:1-3). Paul had his own idea (his own solution, if you will) of what needed to happen and he acted on it. The Holy Spirit used his idea, led him in it, and even re-directed him (Acts 16:6-10). We can learn a lot from Paul's example when we seek God's guidance. For instance:

1. Paul and his companions put themselves in a position to be of service. They did not wait for God to tell them what to do. God responded by directing their course.
2. Paul didn't do it alone. His companions included Silas, Timothy, and Luke. It would have been too much even for Paul to go it alone.
3. Because of this partnership with God, Paul accomplished what he wanted to do. He revisited the places he had been on his 1st journey.
4. The Holy Spirit took Paul's plan and improved it so that he visited even more distant regions and cities. So, the gospel spread and new churches were formed in places like Philippi, Thessalonica, and Corinth – among others

So, bring your ideas to God and always try to put yourself in a position where God can use you. Find some companions who share your vision, ask for God's help, and get started. Who knows what you and the Holy Spirit will accomplish together!

"Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us...." (Eph 3:20)
