A MESSAGE FROM THE ELDERS:

The Bible provides many examples of people who dedicated themselves to a cause, holding nothing back. Jesus is the perfect example. He summed up his life when, speaking from the cross, he said, "It is finished". Similarly, the apostle Paul, following in Jesus' steps, held nothing back. On his 3rd missionary journey, he spent over 2 years in Ephesus (far more than in any other city). And in his farewell to the Elders of the church there he had this to say:

- "I have not hesitated to preach anything that would be helpful to you..." (Acts 20:20)
- "I have not hesitated to proclaim to you the whole will of God." (Acts 20:27)
- "Remember that for three years I never stopped warning each of you night and day with tears." (Acts 20:31)

As your shepherds, we hope that when our time comes to give up the oversight of this awesome congregation, that we in a similar fashion, may be able to truthfully say that we held nothing back.

Today the Lord's work takes many forms and, like Paul, each of us should be fully dedicated to it. We see many examples within our own body: the dedication of the teachers in our childrens program; the parents who teach and train their children at home; the volunteers who help to maintain and improve our facilities and outside activities, the visiting of our sick and grieving, the opening of your homes to one another, the caring for loved ones, the generous financial support of our work, your prayers and your encouragement. In addition, though we are small by comparison to many other fellowships, we are known to several local and national outreaches who our people support. All of this is making a difference in people's lives. We want to encourage you to take heart in the work that you're already doing and urge you to do so more and more, believing that Christianity is spread by good works such as these. And we also want to share a final word from the apostle Paul who wrote this to a young church, perhaps very similar to our own:

"Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for men...It is the Lord Christ you are serving." (Col 3:23-24)
