A MESSAGE FROM THE ELDERS:

In Acts 17:26 the apostle Paul, speaking to a group of Greek philosophers, told them that God “determined the times set for them and the exact places where they would live”. Paul said this refers to nations specifically, but I have always thought it refers to individual Christ-followers as well. Paul himself is a great example. From an early age, he was zealous for God. Even while persecuting Christians, he thought he was serving God. But Jesus himself met him and redirected him on the road to Damascus. After he began preaching, he went to Tarsus, where he would likely have stayed had God not sent Barnabus to bring him to Antioch. From there the Holy Spirit led him on his missionary journeys, where he was often rejected because of his message, even physically abused and cast out. But, through it all, God led him to the next city where He wanted people to hear about Jesus. Being cast out was one way that God directed Paul to his next assignment, if you will. Although Paul himself intended to go to Rome, he did not intend to go as a Roman prisoner. Yet that is how he arrived, through God’s leading. And he preached the gospel there for two whole years while under house arrest, before he was released and continued preaching to the farthest reaches of the Roman Empire. In a similar way, it’s normal for the church, which is full of our dearest friends, to want to “huddle” in one place. But God intentionally scattered the church in Jerusalem through persecution in Acts 7 and 8. That persecution caused the church to grow when “those who were scattered preached the word wherever they went” (Acts 8:4)

Our point is that God often uses circumstances (sometimes pleasant; sometimes not) to direct us to where he wants us to be. Like our early brethren, let us respond by always seeking his direction, telling others about Jesus and serving him fully, wherever he sends us and in whatever circumstance he places us. In this way, you will always take the message of Christ to people who would not otherwise have opportunity to know him.

“You yourselves are our letter, written on our hearts, known and read by everybody.” (2 Cor 3:2)
