How our effort works: The Churches of Christ Disaster Relief Effort immediately responds to any major disaster in the United States, and US Territories by sending truckloads of emergency food, water, cleaning, and other supplies to be distributed to all disaster victims in the disaster area through a local Church of Christ. We are a non-profit corporation, tax-exempt from state and federal income taxes under section 501(a) of the Internal Revenue Code as an organization described in section 501(c)(3). The organization has fourteen employees consisting of an office staff, a warehouse crew, and 5 men who travel across the country going to disaster sites, and also telling Church of Christ congregations about the work of Churches of Christ Disaster Relief Effort. Most important are our unpaid volunteer workers and volunteer truck drivers. They are the secret to the success of our organization.

Help on the way to Reno, Nevada, Harvey, & Chicago Heights, Illinois

August 28th- a 53' trailer of supplies was unloading at the North Virginia Street Church of Christ, in Reno, Nevada, to help families affected by the wildfires.

Saturday morning a trailer of supplies from our Nashville warehouse will be unloading at the Harvey Church of Christ in Harvey, IL.

The Chicago Heights Church of Christ, in IL, will be unloading another shipment of supplies from Nashville at their church building. Harvey and Chicago Heights were hit by severe storms that caused tornadoes in July, followed by flooding caused by heavy rains.

Please pray for all of the families that were victims of the fires, tornadoes, and flooding that have taken place in the last 30 days.

As of August 15th, 2026 the total retail value of goods provided to families in the US affected by major disasters for 2026 is \$2,732,659.92...
