**Step 1:** Respond to the spiritual gifts statements on pages 45–46 by writing the number that indicates how each statement describes you in the blanks on page 47:

- 1 - Almost never
- 2 - Sometimes
- 3 - Almost always

Allow yourself six minutes to answer all questions before moving on to other steps.

**Step 2:** Add each line on page 47, left to right, and place the totaled number in the total column.

**Step 3:** Identify your three highest totaled numbers with the corresponding letter and the spiritual gift it represents (listed on the pages following the assessment).

**Step 4:** Read about your gifts.
