2. Read Romans 12:13, Hebrews 13:2, and 1 Peter 4:7-10. What are believers taught about the practice of hospitality? Are there ways you can grow in this ministry? If so, what's your plan?
3. While Abraham is called a friend of God, the miracle of their relationship is that almighty God came to Abraham and ate a meal with him. Read John 15:13-15. What are some ways that you experience the friendship of Jesus and how are you responding as a beloved friend to Him?
4. Is there a promise that God has made to His people that you struggle to believe? What can you do to find help in this area?
