### **FAITH IN CONTEXT**

We're excited to have Dr. Liz Hall join us for our next Faith in Context event, How to Suffer Well: 5 Lessons I Wish My Church Had Taught Me, Liz is a clinical psychologist at Biola University, who specializes in meaning-making in suffering. She will share her powerful story of how misconceptions and wrong theology almost robbed her of a sense of purpose during her fight with cancer, and why the Christian discipline of lament is crucial to our spiritual and mental health. In addition to Liz's talk, we will reflect on these lessons through a practical workshop and a time of personal, guided reflection on lament.

### **VISION DAY**

As we quickly approach the end of the COS fiscal year (July 1, 2022 - June 30, 2023), we are looking forward to our annual Vision Day coming up in June. Like previous years, we are compiling the many ministry impact and transformation stories from the year and prayerfully considering where God is leading us as a church. The staff and Board of Elders have been developing goals and reviewing budgets for the new year, and we are excited to share these with you.

This year's schedule for Vision Day will look a little different. Instead of combining both the annual business meeting (where we elect and ratify elders and review the 2023-2024 budget) and vision casting (where we share our goals and the areas of focus God has been impressing on our pastor and leadership team), we are going to split these into two separate but consecutive Sundays.

- The Annual Business Meeting will be held on Sunday, June 4, after the Modern Service, to review the budget, elect and ratify elders, and discuss any other business. The meeting will be livestreamed and recorded for those unable to attend in person.
- **Vision Day** will be on **Sunday, June 11**. We will incorporate a vision focus into our normal worship services, which will be followed by a church picnic!

Our goal is to keep worship as the primary focus for our Sunday services, minimizing disruption to our schedule (especially for visitors), while engaging all of our members and attenders in the vision we feel God leading us toward. This also allows us to reach many who would like to participate but can't attend in person.

# **GIVING UPDATE**

### YTD FINANCIAL UPDATE

Not only is March the official beginning of Spring (have you seen all the beautiful flowering trees around the campus?!), but it is also the end of the third quarter in the COS fiscal year (July 1, 2022 - June 30, 2023). And what a quarter it has been!

We continue to praise God for His provision through the generosity of His people! While we're still \$160k behind our expected giving (what is needed to reach our annual budget for the fiscal year), we exceeded our quarterly expected giving by \$133k! For 10 out of the 13 weeks in the quarter, actual giving was higher than what we had planned, based on our annual budget and giving from previous years.

While we still have a long way to go to reach our budget for the year, God is working in hearts and lives through His Spirit, and He is using Church of the Saviour to tangibly show His love to others as we serve the world around us.

#### Our ministries have continued to thrive:

- Our Kids Ministry is serving over 120 children each Sunday, many coming from new families
- Our students are practicing their faith in the community through Faith in Action nights
- 11 students attended our College Meet & Greet to kick-start this new ministry outreach
- 14 women are participating in the Worth It program this term
- Over 40 people are engaging in the "Habits of the Household" Equipping Class for parents
- We hired Caleb, our Student Ministry Associate, and Haig, our new Global Outreach Director, who starts May 8

### And God is meeting many needs around our campus:

- We replaced 5 heat exchangers in 3 of our main buildings
- We repaired the backhoe's hydraulic system, which is critical to maintaining our extensive grounds
- We removed a very large, very dead tree that was hanging over the preschool entrance


