Worries, we all have them. To make it worse, we all know that worries do nothing to solve our problems. Jesus says if we do these three things, He will take care of the rest.

Seek His Kingdom (v. 31):

- Luke 6:12-16; Matthew 26:36-39; Matthew 14:1-23

Do Not Be Afraid (v. 32):

-Luke 9:51

Sell Your Possessions (v. 33):

-Matthew 19:21; Matthew 6:24; Acts 2:44-45;
Luke 3:11; Acts 20:35; Psalm 121:1-2

For family, small group, and personal reflection

These questions are offered as an optional resource for small group study and further personal growth.

If you are on the 10+10 plan (10 minutes reading your bible + 10 minutes praying each day) (and we pray that you are!) discuss your progress with the group.

What are you worried about today? It can be big or small, but you cannot say “nothing.”

Read Luke 6:12-16; Matthew 26:36-39; and Matthew 14:1-23. What did Jesus do when he was worried (if He ever truly was!) From this, how can you seek first His kingdom when you become worried?

Jesus tells us not to be afraid in v. 32. What makes a person brave biblically speaking? Are you afraid of anything right now?

In v. 33 Jesus says to “sell your possessions and give it to charity.” Read the whole verse and discuss how an instruction like this could help to dissipate our worries.

Read v. 34. Using Jesus' metric, where is your heart? If you looked honestly at where you spend your time and money, would it be well spent, or would it be building up worry in your heart? Discuss and pray over any changes you need to make.
