The first three chapters of Ephesians lay a theological foundation for how Paul recommends we live in healthy Christian community. The last three chapters have Paul using that foundation to spell out and address specific concerns the Ephesian community is facing. Our passage for this Sunday is Ephesians 5:1-14. In these verses, Paul is going to tell the Ephesians to guard against and keep certain behaviors out of their corporate life because these behaviors will harm

the community: sexual immorality, coarse talk, impurity. As we saw last week, these are not rules for rules sake but rather rules that come out of a living relationship with Jesus. We will explore how these rules for healthy Christian community life speak to our life together at North Point Church. The following questions can be used for your spiritual journaling or conversations with others this week:

1. Pastor Rob uses the t.v. show "The Walking Dead" to speak about what is allowed in and what is not allowed in to healthy Christian community. What do you envision a healthy Christian community to look like? What should be allowed in and what should not?
2. What were the Apostle Paul's guidelines for being 'in' and being 'out'?
3. What good things of God's creating have become twisted in your own life that need to be addressed?
