Our Easter sermon series continues this week as we study Ephesians 1:5-12. We are preaching through Paul's ancient letter to this beloved church in a style called "Lectio Continua". Also known as "Expository Preaching," we are preaching through every verse in Ephesians. This week we will specifically discuss your Christology (a fancy word for what you believe about Jesus). Additionally, these verses reveal what the Apostle Paul believes and asserts to be true about Jesus. These verses are truly as

powerful as they are beautiful in their description of Jesus. Unfortunately, several words Paul uses have historically drawn our attention away from Jesus, away from essentials, and away from the ultimate meaning of these verses. See if you can spot what those words are. The following questions can help you reflect, journal and discuss today's message on your discipleship journey:

1. Write out your Christology (What do you believe about Jesus: who he is to you personally, and who he is to the world in general. What is true about him?):
2. As you read through Ephesians 1:5-12, what would you say Paul's Christology is? List all the benefits of following the risen Jesus in a community of other Jesus followers.
3. How have the topics of 'predestination' and 'being chosen' been introduced to you in your life? What do you think they mean? How can focusing on these words in Ephesians 1 detract from understanding and applying who Jesus is described to be in this chapter?

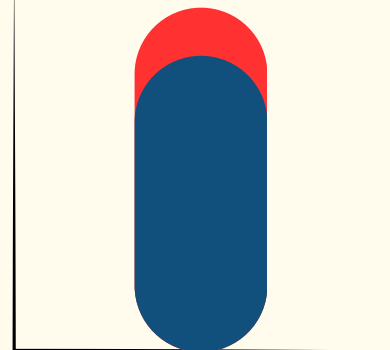
