### THE EPISTLE TO THE EPHESIANS

Paul's Letter to the Ephesians is classically divided into two sections: the first three chapters form a theological treatise and the last three chapters offer practical application. Problems exist with such divisions but we will address those next week. This Sunday at North Point Church we will study the last verses of chapter 3 contained in verses 14-22. In them we find Paul's heartfelt prayer for the Ephesian Christians, first-

century Christ followers, and for us. That prayer is that we will all come to know the height and length and depth, and width of God's love for us in Christ Jesus. I personally love how Paul uses four defining words in this verse, ensuring we are never finished with the joyous task of learning, growing, and discovering God's vast love. This discovery goes beyond the limits of knowledge and points us to a limitless God. The following questions can help you discuss a God with no limits.

1. How does Paul's prayer for the Ephesian Christians speak to you and how you pray for others?
2. Pastor Rob described the theological problems with a "God of the Gaps" theology. What is the alternative to a "God of the Gaps" theology and how does that speak into your life?
3. What steps can you take this week to explore the limitless God and what in your life seems impossible right now?
