

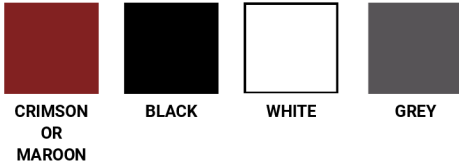


DRESS CODE POLICY

LCA has a uniform dress code. The goals of the uniform look are as follows:

- Promote unity and school spirit among students.
- Promote a dress code that encourages a professional, studious mindset.
- Establish a standard of dress that is easy to maintain and accessible to all.
- Provide comfortable attire cost-effectively.

Dress Code Tops



- T-shirts must be LCA branded from LCA.
- LCA logo t-shirts, polos, long-sleeve shirts, jackets, and hoodies are available through the LCA site, main office and on back-to-school night, and can be worn any day of the week.
- Plain Polos, turtlenecks, knit sweaters, cardigans, blouses, or dress shirts in an approved solid color are acceptable.

Dress Code Bottoms



- Pants must be solid-colored and can include corduroy, Dockers, slacks, dress pants, and cargo pants. Denim (Jeans) must be a single color with no patterns, writings, tears, cuts, patches etc. No pleather, leather, or leggings are allowed. The fit should be neither excessively baggy nor too form-fitting.
- Solid-colored, docker-style shorts, at least knee-length. For girls, skorts, skirts, or jumpers in an approved solid color must be at least knee-length.
- LCA Athletic branded joggers/sweats will be available for purchase and can be worn any day of the week. Athletic bottoms purchased outside of the LCA store are not permitted.

Athletes

- LCA athletes are allowed to wear player-pack items, which include athletic tops and bottoms provided by their coach.

Additional Items

1. **Identification:** All 6th-12th-grade students must wear a neck lanyard and a school-issued ID card at all times.
2. **Clothing Fit:** Attire should fit properly. Clothing must not be excessively baggy or overly form-fitting.
3. **Maintenance:** Clothing should be clean, well-maintained, and free of excessive wear or holes.
4. **Midriff Coverage:** Students should be able to raise their arms without exposing their midriffs.
5. **Tops:** Shirts must not be too low-cut or loose; cleavage must be covered. All tops must have sleeves and effectively cover undergarments.
6. **Footwear:** Students must wear closed-toe shoes that cover both heels and toes. Fully enclosed shoes are mandatory; Crocs, slippers, sandals, or slides are not permitted.
7. **Hairstyles:** Hairstyles should be neat and well-groomed. Unnatural hair colors are not acceptable.
8. **Facial Hair:** Facial hair must be kept neatly trimmed and should not be excessively long.
9. **Jewelry and Piercings:** Students should avoid excessive ear piercings and gauges. Only ear piercings are allowed; no jewelry may be displayed in other body piercings. An exception applies to high school students: small stud nose piercings are permitted at the discretion of the High School Principal and the Dean of Students.
10. **Makeup:** Girls may wear modest makeup, avoiding extreme colors. Boys are not permitted to wear makeup or nail polish.
11. **Tattoos:** Students must ensure tattoos are not excessive and remain covered. Tattoos depicting violence, foul language, nudity, or symbols that may be considered offensive to the values of LCA must be concealed.

Students will be notified of deviations from the school dress code, such as classroom theme days and spirit days.

Tops

- LCA-branded shirts, jackets, sweaters, and hoodies
 - LCA logo polos, t-shirts, long-sleeve shirts, and hoodies are available for purchase through the LCA main office; these are required clothing items
 - Solid Color (white, black, navy, maroon, gray) Turtlenecks, Cardigans, Sweaters, or Dress Blouses without the LCA logo are permitted

Bottoms

- Pants: solid color (khaki, navy, black, white), docker-style dress pants
- LCA logo joggers (no leggings).
- Denim pants in good condition will be permitted if they meet the other guidelines (not too baggy and hanging, not form-fitting, no holes, no jeggings, etc.)
- Skirts: Solid Color (khaki, black, navy, white), must be at least knee-length

Additional Guidelines

- The use of a neck lanyard and **school-issued ID card is required dress code** for all students in 7th-12th grade.
- Clothing should fit the student. It should neither be excessively baggy nor form-fitting. Crop tops that expose the student's midriff or low-cut tops that expose cleavage are not allowed.
- Students should not wear slippers, hats, sunglasses, or caps in class.
- Students should avoid excessive ear piercing and gauges and not wear jewelry on any pierced body part other than the ears. Small stud nose piercings are permitted at the discretion of the High School Principal and Dean of Students.
- No excessive tattoos. Depictions of violence, foul language, nudity, or symbolism that may be considered offensive to LCA's values must be covered.
- Hairstyles should be neat and groomed; no unnatural hair colors are permitted.
