It was from his great-grandparents favorite passage, Psalm 23. Grandpa Fitz tells him how much he also loves that chapter and encourages Shane to get a Bible and read it for himself. Grandpa Fitz's neighbor and best friend, Molly, arrives with a picnic lunch and they go in to eat. With a quick check of the mail, Grandpa Fitz realizes that the stranger from the county isn't giving up so easily. He has issued a CPO! Looks like they might lose the farm after all.
