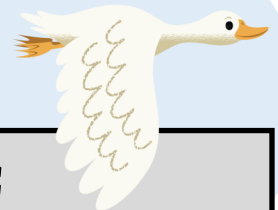
It's a lovely day at Emerald Crossing!
