Sermon Recap

BIG IDEA: The more CAPTIVATED you are by CHRIST, the less captive you will be to the LIES of the ENEMY.

1. LIVE CAPTIVATED by Christ. – Colossians 2:6–7
2. REFUSE to be taken CAPTIVE by COUNTERFEITS. – Colossians 2:8
3. STAND COMPLETE in Christ. – Colossians 2:9–10a
4. WALK in the VICTORY of the CROSS. – Colossians 2:10b–15

Life Group Questions

Opening Question: What has stood out to you from this weekend's message?

1 - What does it look like to live lives captivated by Jesus? What other things in culture try to capture your attention?

2 - What does it look like to "walk in Christ" today? Are you rooted in Christ or drifting toward other things?

3 - Colossians 2:10 reminds us that we are complete in Christ and we have been brought to fullness. Yet many of us live a life of, "My life would be complete if..." Do you ever feel like something is missing in your life? How are you tempted to look for fulfillment outside of Jesus?

4 - How can you cultivate a life that is "overflowing with thanksgiving" despite challenging circumstances?

5 - What areas of your life still feel controlled by the "old self"? How does your new identity change how you live today?

6 - How can your group hold each other accountable to "walk in Him" instead of being taken captive by the world?

Prayer: Take time to pray a modified form of Colossians 2:6-7: *"Jesus we receive you as our Lord and Savior. Help us to live your lives with you. Root our lives in you and build us up. Strengthen us in our faith and help us to live our lives overflowing with thankfulness."*
