Sermon Recap

BIG IDEA: Either Jesus is LORD of ALL or He's not LORD at ALL.

When Jesus is Lord of all:

- In our Homes: We surrender SELF-INTEREST and EGO for LOVE and mutual SUBMISSION. – v. 3:18–21
- In our Work: We surrender AMBITION for INTEGRITY and SERVICE. – v. 3:22–4:1
- In our World: We surrender COMFORT for the MISSION of making His name known. – v. 4:2–4:6

Life Group Questions

Opening Question: What has stood out to you from this weekend's message?

1 - True faith means surrendering every part of ourselves to his leadership. What parts of our lives are we tempted to not surrender to Jesus? (*Maybe finances, relationships, families, etc*).

2 - As a follower of Jesus, Jesus is Lord in our homes. How can you show Christlike love in your home today? What is one intentional step you can take to encourage or serve a family member?

3 - As a follower of Jesus, Jesus is Lord in our work. How can you live as Jesus as Lord in your work this week?

4 - Read Colossians 3:23-24. How does the instruction to work for the Lord transform your perspective on your job or responsibilities?

5 - As a follower of Jesus, Jesus is Lord in our world. This means surrendering your comfort for the mission of making His name known. What might this look like in your life?

6 - Take time to share praises and prayer requests as a group.

Prayer: Colossians 4:2 reminds us to devote ourselves to prayer, being watchful and thankful. Take time to give thanks to God for who He is and all He does. Then take time to pray for the needs in your life.
