



## Who Reminds Me Whose I Am? – Ron Williams

### **Sermon Recap:**

BIG IDEA: In the presence of our ENEMIES, the Good Shepherd prepares a table that reminds us WHO He is and WHOSE we are.

1. The Shepherd KNOWS the ENEMY.
2. The Shepherd LEADS in the PRESENCE of ENEMIES.
3. The Shepherd declares WHOSE WE ARE.
4. Jesus becomes the TABLE.

### **Life Group Questions:**

Starter Question: What stood out to you about this weekend's message?

1 - How did Pastor Ron describe what a table is in Psalm 23?

*(Hint: In A Shepherd Looks at Psalm 23, W. Phillip Keller interprets the "table" in Psalm 23:5 as the high mountain plateau or "mesa" (Spanish for table) where a shepherd leads his sheep to graze during the summer. This "tableland" is prepared by the shepherd beforehand through clearing debris, removing poisonous weeds, and preparing water sources.)*

2 - What enemies have been speaking into your mind and heart lately?

3 - What lie has been speaking louder than the Shepherd's voice?

4 - How does the enemy infiltrate your daily life and perspective to get a "seat at your table"?

5 - The psalmist doesn't say "you remove my enemies from me," but rather "you prepare a table for me in the presence of my enemies." How can you experience God's peace and provision while still facing difficult circumstances or enemies?

6 - How can we, as a group, support each other in keeping the enemy from taking a seat at your tables?
