BIBLE STORY TIME

We had a great time learning about Moses, who was born at a time when the Egyptian Pharaoh felt threatened by the number of Israelites living in Egypt! Out of fear, Pharaoh ordered that all the Israelite baby boys be killed, but baby Moses was saved because God protected him. Moses' mother trusted God and put Moses in a basket in the water, where a kind princess found him. The family was reunited because Miriam, Moses' sister, was brave enough to ask the princess if Miriam's mother could help take care of Moses. You can read to your child the story about Moses and his sister Miriam in the children's Bible in Exodus 2.
