Monday

READ: Revelation 2:8-9

REFLECT: Jesus began his letter to Smyrna with, "I know..." He knew their suffering, their poverty, and the pressure they faced. Before he offered instruction, he reminded them that he saw them. There are seasons when it feels like God has forgotten us, but God's Word says otherwise. He knows exactly where you are, and he has not lost sight of you.

RESPOND: Tell God honestly what you're carrying today. Thank him that nothing in your life escapes his attention.

Tuesday

READ: John 11:32-36

REFLECT: When Jesus arrived at Lazarus's tomb, he didn't immediately explain what he was doing. He wept with Mary and Martha before he worked the miracle. Sometimes God doesn't change our circumstances as quickly as we'd like, but that doesn't mean he has stopped caring. His compassion is present even when his purposes aren't fully clear.

RESPOND: Where do you need to remember that Jesus is with you today? Spend a moment thanking him for his compassion.

Wednesday

READ: Romans 8:28-29

REFLECT: There are times when we don't understand what God is doing. That's when trust is so important. Paul reminds us that God is always working for the good of those who love him, even when we can't see how. We may not have answers for every circumstance, but we do know God's character. He is faithful, wise, and good.

RESPOND: What situation do you need to place back into God's hands? Ask him to help you trust his heart when you can't see his plan.

Thursday

READ: Matthew 16:24; John 16:33

REFLECT: Jesus never promised his followers an easy road. He told them to take up their cross and to expect trouble in this world. He also reminded them he has overcome the world. Our hope isn't found in a trouble-free life, but in walking with the victorious One.

RESPOND: What would faithfulness look like in your circumstances today? Ask God for courage to follow him, whatever the cost.

Friday

READ: Revelation 2:10-11

REFLECT: Jesus ended his letter with a challenge, "Be faithful..." He wasn't asking the church to figure it all out, but to trust him. Faithfulness isn't measured by how easy life is, but by how we follow Jesus. When we follow him, we can have hope because our lives are secure in his hands.

RESPOND: What is one area where God is calling you to remain faithful? Ask him to give you strength to trust him today.
