Monday

READ: Revelation 2:12-17

REFLECT: Little by little the believers in Pergamum had begun listening to voices that were pulling them away from God. We daily are being shaped by something—friends, social media, news, entertainment, or our own desires. Following Jesus starts with asking an honest question: “Whose voice am I listening to the most?”

RESPOND: What voice has your attention the most these days? Ask God to help you recognize influences that pull you away from him.

Tuesday

READ: Revelation 2:18-29

REFLECT: Jesus' words to the church at Thyatira remind us compromise rarely happens overnight. It usually starts with one small decision, one area where we stop paying attention. Over time those little compromises shape our hearts. Jesus isn't trying to make life harder. He is trying to protect us from drifting farther than we ever intended to go.

RESPOND: Is there an area where you've been excusing a small compromise? Ask God for the courage to deal with it today.

Wednesday

READ: 1 Corinthians 10:1-13

REFLECT: Every Christian faces temptation. Paul doesn't tell us we'll never struggle, but he does remind us God is faithful. God always provides a way to remain faithful, even if it isn't the easiest option. Sometimes that “way out” is walking away, asking for help, or choosing obedience when no one else sees.

RESPOND: Where do you need God's strength to resist temptation today? Look for the “way out” he's already providing.

Thursday

READ: 1 Corinthians 10:23-24, 31-33

REFLECT: Our choices affect more than just ourselves. Rather than asking “Can I do this?” we should ask “Will this help someone else follow Jesus?” Love thinks beyond personal preferences, choosing to set aside a freedom so someone else's faith can grow.

RESPOND: Is there a decision you need to view through the lens of loving others? Ask God to help you make choices that point people toward Jesus.

Friday

READ: Philippians 4:8-9

REFLECT: Paul encourages us to think about whatever is true, honorable, pure, lovely, and praiseworthy—to exchange unhealthy thoughts for good and godly ones. Whatever fills our minds eventually shapes our hearts. As we spend time in God's Word and focus on him, his truth begins to crowd out other voices.

RESPOND: What is one influence you need less of this week? What is one habit that would help you keep your mind focused on Jesus?
