TODAY: MARCH 7-8

Bible Story: The Ten Lepers *Luke 17:11-19*

Big Idea: Jesus Loves.

Focus: Jesus loves everyone.

Memory Verse: "Just as the Father has loved me, I have loved you. Now remain in my love." *John 15:9 (NirV)*

Bible Story Summary:

Read and meditate on Acts 10:34-35; 1 John 3:1a; Psalm 106:1-2

As Jesus walked toward Jerusalem, He met ten men with leprosy. They called to Jesus for help, and He told them to show themselves to the priests. As they walked away, they were healed. Only one, a Samaritan, returned to thank Jesus. Jesus asked why the others didn't return, then told the man, "Your faith has made you well."

He Question: Is there anyone Jesus doesn't love?

Jesus loves every single person, no matter who they are and what they've done. Even if the whole world rejects someone, Jesus loves them.

We Question: How can we respond to Jesus' love?

We can respond to Jesus with praise and gratefulness for all He does for us.

Me Question: How is God inviting me to respond?

Kids will be given the opportunity to reflect on the truth they learned about God and respond accordingly.

Have your child think of someone that they could show the love of Jesus to this week. What could they do for that person? There might be people that you look down on because they dress differently than you or have a different personality than you. Maybe that person doesn't feel a part of the friend group. DAY 1

READ *John 15:9*

You are working this month to memorize this verse. With the help of a parent, find a way to play some music. It could be a radio, a phone, Alexa, or something else. Have your parent play some music. As the music plays, dance around! Have some fun! Have your parent stop the music at some point. When the music stops, freeze and say the memory verse. Do this five or six times to help you memorize this month's memory verse.

PRACTICE this memory verse as a reminder that Jesus loves you.

DAY 2

READ *Acts 10:34-35*

The word "accept" is repeated in these verses. Peter realizes that God treats everyone the same and has no favorites. He treats everyone equally. God accepts people from every nation. God accepts anyone who respects Him. God accepts anyone who does what is right. That means God loves you! He accepts you. He thinks you are so unique and special.

DAY 3

READ Luke 17:11-19

Would you like having to shout "I am unclean" to anyone that came close to you? These 10 men felt unwanted and unloved. They were outcasts. They lived with this sickness and would have done anything to be healed. Jesus did not care that they were sick. He loved them. He listened to them and even healed them. Jesus loves you! He does not have favorites. He values you for who you are and loves you so much!
