Bible Story: Paul's Conversion *Acts 9:1-31*

Big Idea: Jesus changes everything

Focus: Jesus changes me

Memory Verse: "When anyone lives in Christ, the new creation has come. The old is gone! The new is here!" *2 Corinthians 5:17 (NIRV)*

Bible Story Summary:

Read *Acts 9:1-31, Ezekiel 36:26-27, Psalm 51:10, Galatians 2:20*

Saul was helping hunt down and arrest followers of Jesus. On the way to Damascus, he saw a bright light. Jesus spoke to him and asked why Saul was persecuting Him. Saul was blind for three days until a believer named Ananias prayed for him. Saul was healed and he began following Jesus. He eventually changed his name to Paul and became a great missionary. Paul preached the Gospel wherever he went and planted many churches.

He Question: How can Jesus change lives?

Jesus forgives sin. When someone trusts in Him, He takes their sin and exchanges it for His goodness. The Holy Spirit helps them grow to be more like Him.

We Question: Is there anyone Jesus can't change?

Anyone who calls on the name of Jesus and repents of their sin can be saved. No one is too bad or too far gone who can't be rescued by Him.

Me Question: What does God want me to know about Him and what does this mean for my life?

Kids will be given the opportunity to reflect on the truth they learned about God and respond accordingly.



Play a game of opposites. Ask your child the opposite of the following things: sunny, up, big, empty, hot. Now ask what the opposite of dirty is. Talk about how our hearts are unclean and dirty before we ask Jesus to forgive us. Tell them that Jesus makes our hearts new, cleaning all of our sin.

Pray for someone your family knows who doesn't know Jesus. Ask Jesus to help this person become a part of God's family and be made new.

DAY 1

READ *2 Corinthians 5:17 (NIRV)*

Just like a caterpillar changes into a new creature, this verse reminds us that we are a new creation when we become a part of God's family.

Memorize this verse by moving like different creatures. Pick 2 different ways to practice this verse. Circle the 2 you chose.

March like an ant.

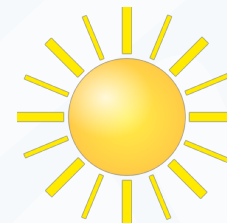
Crawl like a caterpillar.

DAY 2

READ *Acts 9:1-5 (NIRV)*

Saul was putting believers of Jesus in jail. His was on his way to arrest some of Jesus' followers. Circle what blinded him.



Jesus sent a bright light from heaven, and then Jesus spoke to Saul. After Saul met Jesus, he completely changed! He became a follower of Jesus and was completely made new. His sin was gone. Jesus changes you when you become part of His family, too!

DAY 3

READ Psalm 51:10 (NirV)

Before we ask Jesus to forgive our sin and lead our lives, our hearts are not clean.

Color this heart black.



This verse tells us that God gives us a clean, pure heart! He makes us new.

Leave this heart white.

Thank Jesus for making your heart clean.
