Bible Story: Paul & Barnabas in Lystra *Acts 14:8-20*

Big Idea: Jesus changes everything

Focus: Jesus changes who we worship

Memory Verse: "When anyone lives in Christ, the new creation has come. The old is gone! The new is here!" *2 Corinthians 5:17 (NirV)*

Bible Story Summary:

Read Acts 14:8-20, Exodus 20:3, Psalm 145:2-3, Romans 1:25

Paul and Barnabas healed a man in Lystra. When the locals saw what happened, they began worshiping the men as gods. Paul and Barnabas begged them not to worship them and to turn away from their false gods. Some men from another city came and turned the people against Paul and Barnabas. They stoned Paul and dragged him out of the city, believing he was dead. Paul got up, dusted himself off, and returned to the city.

He Question: Why is God worthy of worship?

God is the one true God. He is the Creator of all things and is in control of all things. He is high above anyone else and deserves all of the glory because of who He is.

We Question: Why do people worship other gods?

Some people haven't heard the truth of the Gospel of Jesus. Some have heard it but choose to worship something else. Our job is to tell the world about the one true God.

Me Question: How is God inviting me to respond?

Kids will be given the opportunity to reflect on the truth they learned about God and respond accordingly.

Bed Time



Grab a flashlight and turn off the bedroom lights so the room is dark. Shine the flashlight onto your child. Share how the people in the city thought Paul and Barnabas deserved the spotlight because of what they did but they both knew they weren't the true heroes. Then move the flashlight beam so it points straight to the ceiling. Remind them that Paul and Barnabas pointed the spotlight straight up to God. They knew how great God was and did not want to take the credit. Help them come up with a way that they could do that in their day tomorrow.

DAY 2

READ *Exodus 20:3 (NirV)*

Go find your favorite toy and hold onto it. You might love playing with it, but that toy cannot hug you back, smile at you, or take care of you. Only God can do that! Having "no other gods" means no toy, sweet treat, or tv show should be more important to you than God. He wants to be the most important in your heart each day.

DAY 3

READ Acts 14:15 (NirV)

You just drew the most beautiful picture and someone came up to you and said "Wow! Those crayons are so smart for drawing that beautiful picture." You would probably say "The crayons didn't draw it, I DID!" You learned in large group that Paul and Barnabas met a man who couldn't walk. God gives Paul the power to heal him. The man was so excited that he started dancing. Paul and Barnabas tell the people that it wasn't them that healed the man, but that God was the one who did this. They knew that whenever they did something that was kind, helpful, or awesome, they should thank the one true God. **With the help of a parent, complete the verse.**
