Bible Story: Paul and Silas in Prison *Acts 16:16-40*

Big Idea: Jesus changes everything

Focus: Jesus frees us

Memory Verse: "When anyone lives in Christ, the new creation has come. The old is gone! The new is here!" *2 Corinthians 5:17 (NirV)*

Bible Story Summary:

Read *Acts 16:16-40*, *John 8:32-36*, *Romans 8:1-2*, *1 Peter 2:16*

Paul and Silas were wrongfully thrown into prison. At midnight, Paul and Silas were singing to God. Suddenly, there was a great earthquake. Their chains fell away and all the prison doors opened. When the prison guard realized the prisoners had stayed in place, he listened to the Gospel. The guard and his whole household believed in Jesus and were baptized.

He Question: How is Jesus able to free us?

Because Jesus died on the cross and rose from the grave, He has power over all things, including sin and death.

We Question: Why do we need Jesus to free us?

We are slaves to sin. Jesus frees us from sin, shame, and guilt. He frees us from death and gives us eternal life.

Me Question: How is God inviting me to respond?

Kids will be given the opportunity to reflect on the truth they learned about God and respond accordingly.

Drive Time



While you are driving, turn the radio to a station that is pure static. Ask your child if this is enjoyable to listen to? Then flip to a perfectly clear station with a song they love. Explain that living in anger, selfishness, and guilt is like filling your mind with constant static. It keeps you trapped in a bad mood. Jesus clears up that signal. He died on the cross to forgive you of all your mistakes and deletes that static in your heart so you are free to hear His peace and be free!

DAY 1

READ *2 Corinthians 5:17 (NirV)*

All month long you have been learning this verse. This is the last week so hopefully you know it well! With a pencil or pen write out the verse on a piece of paper. Grab a black crayon or marker. Begin by saying the verse a few times. Then choose one word and color over it so you can't see it. See if you can still say the verse. Continue coloring over words until you have no words left. Can you still say it?

What word did you choose to color over first?

What was the last word you colored over?

DAY 2

READ *Romans 8:1-2 (NirV)*

Have you ever made a big mistake and had to sit in a time out? Mistakes can make you feel bad on the inside. Sometimes a voice in your head might whisper "you are bad" or "God is mad at you? Those feelings are often judgments or labels that you put on yourself. When Jesus died on the cross, He took away all of your mistakes and bad choices. He never puts a "bad" label on you! He loves you so much and forgives you so that you can be completely free. With the help of a parent, unmix the phrase to remind you of his amazing love.

DAY 3

READ Acts 16:25 (NIRV)

Imagine being stuck in a dark, cold jail cell. Your feet are locked up and you drag around heavy chains. You can't play, run, or even stand up. This is what happened to Paul and Silas. This week you learned that they were put in prison for telling people about how much Jesus loved them. Paul and Silas could have been scared, angry, or even cried, but they didn't. They decided to sing songs of praise to God because they knew they belonged to Jesus. You can't remove those chains of sin on your own. When you let Jesus become your forever friend, He sets you free!

This verse shares that Jesus makes us completely free! He sent His son to die on the cross for your bad choices. Having true freedom means you are free to be a helper. You have the choice on how you will use the freedom He gives you. Using kind words or sharing your ice cream when a friend drops their cone on accident are all examples of using your freedom to do good things for God.

Take a moment and pray. Thank Him for sending His son to die on the cross for your mistakes. Ask Him to help you to use that freedom to do kind things that bring Him glory.
