TODAY: AUGUST 15-16

Bible Story: The Fall *Genesis 3*

Big Idea: God is the Creator

Focus: God is Holy but people sin

Memory Verse: "All things were created in Him. He created everything in Heaven and on Earth..." *2 Corinthians 5:17 (NirV)*

Bible Story Summary:

Read Genesis 3, Romans 3:23; Isaiah 59:2; Exodus 15:11; James 4:17

God created a perfect world where people were in a perfect relationship with Him. A serpent tempted Eve. She and Adam ate fruit from the tree. They became separated from God. They were no longer perfect, and the world was broken by their sin. They hid from God in shame, but the Lord did not leave them without hope. He promised a Savior who would defeat the serpent and free all people from the power of sin.

He Question: Does God do anything wrong?

God is holy. He never sins. He created a perfect world that was broken by sin.

We Question: Why do people do wrong things?

Sin is anything we think, say or do that disobeys God. Everyone sins, choosing our way instead of God's way.

Me Question: How is God inviting me to respond?

Kids will be given the opportunity to reflect on the truth they learned about God and respond accordingly.



After dinner, grab a shallow bowl and fill it with water. Shake a lot of black pepper into the center of the water and share that the pepper represents the sins that we make that mess up the perfect world that God created. Have your child put a small drop of dish soap on the tip of their finger and try to put their soapy finger into the center of the peppered water. The pepper should shoot away to the edges of the bowl leaving a perfectly clear circle of water around their finger. Explain to them that God is perfect. Just like the soap pushed the pepper away, God's holiness can't be near sin. Remind them that even though their sin separates them from God, He loved them so much that He sent His Son to die on the cross for their mistakes so that they can be with Him forever.

READ *Colossians 1:16 (NirV)*

READ *Romans 3:23 (NirV)*

Have you ever tried to count the stars in the sky? There are just too many and you will never be able to count them all. You will fall short. This is what making mistakes is like. This verse says that EVERYONE has sinned. You are not perfect and will mess up and fall short. Every wrong choice you make is called a sin. Are you perfect? No! Only God is perfect and He knows you are not. He loves you so much that He sent His Son to this earth to help you and forgive you of all your mistakes.

DAY 3

READ Genesis 3:1-10 (NirV)

She talks Adam into eating it too, breaking God's one rule. This is when sin entered the world. They were ashamed of their sin. But God didn't leave them without hope.
