TODAY: AUGUST 22-23

Bible Story: Tower of Babel *Genesis 11:1-9*

Big Idea: God is the Creator

Focus: No one is greater than God

Memory Verse: "All things were created in Him. He created everything in heaven and on earth... All things have been created by Him and for Him."
2 Corinthians 5:17 (NirV)

Bible Story Summary:

Read *Genesis 11:1-9*, *Jeremiah 10:6*; *Psalms 86:8-10*; *John 14:6*.

God instructed people to fill the Earth. Instead, they chose to gather in one spot and build a city, including a great tower so that they could make a name for themselves. God protected them from their wrong desires by confusing their language. They couldn't understand each other and stopped trying to build the city. God scattered the people throughout the earth.

He Question: Who is greater than God?

No one will ever be greater than God. Because He is the Creator, He is in charge of all things.

We Question: Is there a way for us to get to God?

Because our sin separates us from God, believing in Jesus is the only way to have a relationship with Him.

Me Question: How is God inviting me to respond?

Kids will be given the opportunity to reflect on the truth they learned about God and respond accordingly.



While you are driving, play a game with your kid. Start out with a penny and ask them to name something bigger. Once they share, you have to come up with something bigger than that. Then have them share something that is bigger than yours. After a few rounds, ask them who made the world? Remind them that no matter how big, God made them all. There is no one greater than Him.

DAY 1

READ *Colossians 1:16 (NirV)*

Today, you're going to play a fun game to help you memorize the memory verse. Find a way to play some music. It could be a radio, a phone, Alexa, or something else. Start the song. As the music plays, dance around! Have some fun! Then at some point, stop the music. When the music stops, freeze and say the memory verse. Do this, five or six times, to help you memorize this month's memory verse.

What song did you dance to?

PRACTICE this verse so you remember that God is the Creator

DAY 2

READ *Psalms 86:8-10 (NirV)*

These verses look at who God is. There is nothing in the universe that can compare to God. There is no roller coaster, tall building, or giant ocean that God is not more powerful than. People can build rockets or use their brains to create some pretty amazing things, but God can do so much more. God's work is so special that it leaves no competition. He alone is God. In the space, draw a picture of two things that when you look at them, you see how amazing God is.

KNOW that no one is greater than God

DAY 3

READ Genesis 11:1-9 (NirV)

Legos! Everyone loves legos. You can get creative and build so many amazing things with them. These verses share a story about a group of people who built the biggest, tallest tower. They built it to show off. They wanted people to look at them forgetting that God is the one who is truly great. God doesn't want you to be in the spotlight where you receive all the attention and only think of yourself. God wants you to use your talents to point people back to Him.
