TODAY: AUGUST 8-9

Bible Story: Wonderfully Made *Genesis 1:26-31, 2:4-25*

Big Idea: God is the Creator

Focus: God created me in His image

Memory Verse: "All things were created in Him. He created everything in Heaven and on Earth..." *Colossians 1:16 (NirV)*

Bible Story Summary:

Read *Genesis 1:26-31; 2:4-25, Genesis 1:27, Psalm 139:14, Isaiah 43:7.*

God created Adam in His own image, and Adam lived in the perfect garden of Eden. God told Adam not to eat from the tree of knowledge of good and evil. God declared it was not good for Adam to be alone. Adam named every creature, but none were good helpers for Him. God created Eve from Adam's rib. They lived in a perfect relationship with God in the beautiful garden He created.

He Question: How does God feel about people?

God uniquely made people in His image. God loves His people and has always wanted a relationship with them.

We Question: Why did God make people?

God created people to know Him, to worship Him and to be loved by Him.

Me Question: What does God want me to know about Him and what does this mean for my life?

Kids will be given the opportunity to reflect on the truth they learned about God and respond accordingly.



Before going to bed, grab a flashlight and turn off the lights. Shine the flashlight towards an empty wall so you can create some shadow puppets. Together create a few different shapes and shadows. Talk about how the shadows copied everything you did. Share with them that being made in the image of God is like being God's beautiful shadow each day. Wherever you go, you get to copy Him. God created you uniquely with a special purpose.

READ *Colossians 1:16 (NirV)*

READ *Genesis 1:27 (NirV)*

READ Genesis 1:26-31 (NirV)

God spent a whole week creating the world. He spoke and the bright sun, deep oceans, animals, and bugs were all made. But God saved His best creation for last. On the sixth day, He created people. He made you to be just like Him so that you could love, laugh, and be kind. He didn't create you to just sit around but instead created you with an important job. He wants you to be His helper of His beautiful work.
