Bible Story: Jacob's Dream *Genesis 27-28*

Big Idea: God Never Changes

Focus: God Never Changes

Memory Verse: "Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever."
Hebrews 13:8 (NirV)

Bible Story Summary:

Read *Genesis 27-28, Malachi 3:6a, Romans 8:38-39, Lamentations 3:22-23.*

God made the same promise to Abraham's son Isaac that he made to Abraham. Isaac and Rebekah had twin sons, Esau and Jacob. Isaac intended to bless Esau, but Jacob deceived him and received the blessing instead. Esau was angry, so Jacob fled. On his journey, Jacob dreamed of a ladder reaching heaven and heard God reaffirm the covenant. Despite Jacob's deceit, God revealed His plan and faithfulness through His promises.

He Question: Does God change over time?

God is always the same. We can trust that He is always good, loving and in control.

We Question: Do our mistakes change God's love for us?

No! God's love for us doesn't change. He loves us no matter what.

Me Question: How is God inviting me to respond?

Kids will be given the opportunity to reflect on the truth they learned about God and respond accordingly.



Grab a bowl and place an ice cube in it. Set it in the middle of your table while you eat. Hopefully by the end of dinner it will be a puddle of water. Ask your kids if they can turn the water back into an ice cube? They should say No because it has completely changed. Remind them that there are things all around us that change. Most everything around you can change shape, get older, or even break, BUT God never changes. His promises last forever. You can trust that He is always good, loving, and in control.

READ Genesis 28:15 (NirV)
