Monday

READ: Psalm 23:1a

REFLECT: A shepherd guides, protects, and provides for the sheep. David is declaring his full dependence on God. Everything in life flows from who is leading you. If God is truly your shepherd, then you are not meant to lead your own life. Many of our struggles come from trying to take control instead of trusting his leadership.

RESPOND: Ask yourself, who is leading my life right now? Surrender one decision or area to God's leadership today.

Tuesday

READ: Psalm 23:1-2

REFLECT: "I shall not want" points to a deep trust in God's provision. When we don't trust God to provide, we strive, try to control, and chase more. The Good Shepherd leads us beside still waters and into green pastures — places of rest, not striving. When we trust him, we can stop trying to carry what was never ours to control (or carry).

RESPOND: Where are you striving instead of trusting? Take a moment today to release control and rest in God's provision.

Wednesday

READ: Psalm 23:3

REFLECT: "He restores my soul" speaks to more than physical rest. Many of us are exhausted not because we are busy, but because we are disconnected from the Shepherd. We look for escape in things that cannot restore our souls. True restoration comes from surrender, not escape. God meets us in our weariness and renews our souls.

RESPOND: What is draining your soul right now? Spend a few quiet moments with God, asking him to restore you.

Thursday

READ: Psalm 23:4

REFLECT: Even in the darkest valley, David says he does not fear because God is with him. Fear doesn't disappear because our circumstances change — it fades when we trust that God is with us. The Shepherd does not always remove the valley, but he always walks through it with us. His presence is greater than our darkest moments.

RESPOND: What fear are you carrying today? Remind yourself through the day: God is with me, even here.

Friday

READ: Psalm 23:5-6

REFLECT: God prepares a table "in the presence of my enemies." God's provisions and blessings are not dependent on perfection; they exist in the middle of tension and opposition. God invites us to receive and trust his goodness, even when life feels uncertain.

RESPOND: Do you struggle more trying to earn grace or receive it? Take time to let God care for you without seeking to control everything that comes your way.
