Monday

READ: Psalm 23:4

REFLECT: Following the Shepherd does not mean avoiding hard or fearful seasons; it's about walking through them with the Shepherd. Fear grows when we focus on the valley instead of the Shepherd. David shifts his focus from the danger around him to the presence beside him. Courage begins when we realize we are not walking alone.

RESPOND: What “valley” are you currently facing? Remind yourself today: God is with me, even here.

Tuesday

READ: Isaiah 41:10

REFLECT: God's command, “Do not fear,” is always tied to his presence, “for I am with you.” Courage is not the absence of fear; it is the presence of trust. When we rely on our own strength, fear overwhelms us. But, when we lean on God's strength, we find stability in uncertainty. Indeed, God's presence is the foundation for our courage.

RESPOND: Where is fear trying to control your decisions? Ask God to replace fear with trust in his presence.

Wednesday

READ: John 10:11-14

REFLECT: Jesus calls himself the Good Shepherd who knows his sheep and stays close to them. He remains present and committed. His nearness means we are never abandoned, even in our darkest moments. Courage grows when we trust that the Shepherd is not distant but actively cares for us. We don't have to navigate life alone.

RESPOND: Do you view Jesus as near or distant in your struggles? Take a moment to acknowledge his presence with you right now.

Thursday

READ: 2 Corinthians 12:9-10

REFLECT: Paul reminds us that God's power is made perfect in weakness. When we lack courage, we may feel inadequate or overwhelmed. But those moments invite us to depend on God's strength instead of our own. We can't manufacture courage. God provides it. When we surrender our weakness, his strength becomes evident.

RESPOND: Where do you feel weak today? Invite God's strength into that area.

Friday

READ: Joshua 1:9

REFLECT: God calls Joshua to be strong and courageous, not because of his ability, but because of God's presence. This same truth applies to us. We can move forward even when we feel afraid. Courage means stepping forward because God is with us. When the Shepherd leads, we can follow with confidence.

RESPOND: What step of faith have you been hesitant to take? Take one small step forward today, trusting God is with you.
