Monday

READ: Psalm 23:4-5

REFLECT: The phrase “you prepare a table before me” reveals intentional care and provision. A shepherd would inspect the pasture, removing anything harmful to the sheep. Similarly, God prepares the way for his people with wisdom, protection, and love. The Shepherd cares for us deeply. His preparation reminds us we can trust him.

RESPOND: Where have you seen God’s care and provision in your life? Thank him right now for being a Shepherd who prepares the way for you.

Tuesday

READ: Psalm 23:5; 1 John 2:16

REFLECT: Enemies are present even when God provides. Scripture reminds us that the enemy’s attacks are aimed at our hearts and minds, seeking to distort our trust in God. The enemy wants us to believe lies about our worth, our identity, and God’s goodness. Even in the presence of those enemies, the Shepherd is near and continues to provide.

RESPOND: What enemies or lies are attacking your heart right now? Ask God to help you recognize and reject those lies.

Wednesday

READ: Psalm 23:4-5; Joshua 1:9

REFLECT: It can be easy to focus on our enemies rather than the Shepherd beside us. The Shepherd prepares the table “in the presence” of enemies, not after they disappear. Courage and peace come when we fix our eyes on the Shepherd instead of the threat.

RESPOND: What has been consuming your focus lately? Your enemies or your Shepherd? Pause today and intentionally refocus your heart on God’s presence.

Thursday

READ: Luke 19:1-10

REFLECT: Though rejected by others, Zacchaeus was welcomed by Jesus with grace, not condemnation. The Shepherd prepares a place for us, not because we’ve earned it, but because he loves us. His table becomes a declaration of grace in front of every accusation and lie.

RESPOND: Do you truly believe you have a place at Jesus’ table? Spend time thanking him for his grace and acceptance.

Friday

READ: Romans 8:31-39

REFLECT: The enemy may accuse, tempt, or attack, but he does not have the final word. The Shepherd’s presence declares our value, security, and belonging. Nothing can separate us from the love of Christ. This includes fear, failure, opposition, or spiritual attack. The Shepherd’s care is stronger than every enemy we face.

RESPOND: What accusation or fear do you need to surrender to God today? Remind yourself today that the Shepherd invites you to trust his care and provision.
