Monday

READ: Colossians 3:1–4

REFLECT: Paul reminds believers that their identity has changed with Jesus, and so their priorities must change as well. Jesus is not just a part of a believer's life—he is the center of it. When we understand that our lives are “hidden with Christ,” it reshapes how we see success, suffering, and everyday decisions.

RESPOND: What thoughts currently shape your priorities? Earthly or eternal ones? Start today by intentionally fixing your thoughts on Jesus.

Tuesday

READ: Colossians 3:5–7

REFLECT: Paul tells believers to “put to death” the behaviors of their former lives. Sin is not something we can manage; it is something to remove. The habits and desires of the old life no longer fit our new identity in Christ. True transformation begins when we stop tolerating what Christ has already defeated.

RESPOND: Identify one habit or attitude that belongs to your “old life.” Ask God for the strength to actively remove it.

Wednesday

READ: Colossians 3:8–11

REFLECT: Paul calls believers to remove destructive attitudes like anger, slander, and lying. These behaviors damage relationships and contradict the new life in Christ. Christ unites our identity and relationships.

RESPOND: Do your words and attitudes reflect your old life or your new one? Practice speaking words today that build others up.

Thursday

READ: Colossians 3:12–14

REFLECT: Paul reminds the church that they are God's chosen and beloved people, and their lives should reflect that. Compassion, kindness, humility, patience, and forgiveness should shape how we treat one another. Above all, love holds everything together in unity. These qualities grow from the love we already have in Christ.

RESPOND: Choose one virtue from this passage to practice today. Ask God to help you extend forgiveness and patience toward others.

Friday

READ: Colossians 3:15–17

REFLECT: Paul describes a Christ-centered life. The peace of Christ guides decisions, gratitude shapes attitudes, and God's Word fills our lives. When God's Word dwells among believers, it strengthens the entire community. Whatever we say or do should reflect our identity in Christ. It's not about managing rules but living in relationship with him.

RESPOND: Let Christ's peace guide one decision you face today. How can this action reflect your identity in Christ?
