Monday

READ: Colossians 1:15–18; Romans 10:9

REFLECT: Paul reminds us that Jesus is not only Savior, but Lord over all of creation and life. He holds everything together and deserves full authority over every part of us. We are called not only to believe in Jesus but to confess him as Lord. True faith means surrendering every part of ourselves to his leadership.

RESPOND: Is Jesus Lord of all of your life or just part of it? Surrender one area you've been holding back.

Tuesday

READ: Colossians 3:18–21

REFLECT: One of the primary places our faith is lived out is at home with our spouses and children. Submission, love, obedience, and encouragement reflect Christ's character. When Jesus is Lord, we begin to serve rather than demand and build up rather than tear down. Our home becomes a place where the gospel is practiced daily.

RESPOND: How can you show Christlike love in your home today? Take one intentional step to encourage or serve a family member.

Wednesday

READ: Colossians 3:22–24

REFLECT: Paul reminds believers that our work belongs to the Lord. When Jesus is Lord, our motivation changes. We no longer work for approval, recognition, or personal ambition, but for Jesus. This frees us from comparison and striving and calls us to integrity and diligence. Every task we do becomes an opportunity to honor and serve him.

RESPOND: What motivates your work? Choose one task today to do "heartily for the Lord."

Thursday

READ: Colossians 4:2–4

REFLECT: Paul calls believers to be devoted to prayer, staying watchful and thankful. Making Jesus Lord means staying connected and aware of his work around us. Prayer aligns our hearts with his purpose and opens our eyes to opportunities to share the gospel. God uses ordinary people who are attentive to him and what he is doing.

RESPOND: Set aside time today for intentional, focused prayer. Ask God to open a door for a spiritual conversation.

Friday

READ: Colossians 4:5–6

REFLECT: Paul calls believers to live wisely and make the most of every opportunity. When Jesus is Lord, it shows in how we interact with people. Our words should be gracious, thoughtful, and shaped by the gospel. Everyday moments become opportunities to reflect Jesus. We start to see our lives as part of his mission.

RESPOND: How are you making the most of the opportunities God gives you? Who in your life needs to experience Christ through your words today?
