## Monday

**READ:** Psalm 103:1–2

**REFLECT:** David preaches to himself, “Bless the Lord, O my soul.” Sometimes worship begins before our feelings. Life fills our minds with stress, distraction, and disappointment, and over time we forget who God is and all he has done. Worship has a way of reorienting us when life is pulling us in every direction.

**RESPOND:** Begin today by thanking God out loud for who he is. Ask yourself: What has my heart been focused on lately?

## Tuesday

**READ:** Psalm 103:2–5

**REFLECT:** We tend to remember what is wrong and overlook what God has done. David lists forgiveness, healing, redemption, love, mercy, and renewal. Sometimes we experience spiritual amnesia — we forget the goodness of God even while living in it. Gratitude grows when we intentionally stop and remember his faithfulness.

**RESPOND:** Write down three ways God has been good to you recently. Spend time thanking him before bringing him your requests.

## Wednesday

**READ:** Psalm 103:8–12

**REFLECT:** David rejoices not only in what God does but also in what God refuses to do. God is compassionate, patient, and full of love. He does not treat us as our sins deserve. Instead, he removes our sins “as far as the east is from the west.” When we remember God’s mercy, worship becomes personal and deeply meaningful.

**RESPOND:** Are you carrying guilt or shame? Thank God for his mercy and forgiveness.

## Thursday

**READ:** Psalm 103:13–18

**REFLECT:** David compares God’s love to the compassion of a father toward his children. God knows our weakness, our limits, and how fragile we can be. Yet his love remains steady and faithful through every generation. God’s character does not change. Worship anchors our hearts in the unchanging goodness of God when everything else is uncertain.

**RESPOND:** Where do you need to trust God’s character right now? Pause today and remind yourself of one truth about who God is.

## Friday

**READ:** Psalm 103:19–22

**REFLECT:** In Psalm 103, David reminds himself that God reigns over all. Worship lifts our eyes beyond our worries and reconnects us to the greatness of God. When we start prayer with rejoicing, our perspective changes. We remember the many reasons we have to praise him.

**RESPOND:** Spend a few moments worshiping God before asking him for anything. Ask yourself: Have I been more focused on my problems or on God’s greatness?
