Monday

READ: Psalm 27:14

REFLECT: Nobody enjoys waiting. Waiting can feel frustrating and uncertain. However, Scripture reminds us that waiting is part of our faith journey. David encourages us to be strong and courageous while we wait because God is still at work. The waiting may feel like a gap in the story, but God is doing something in that space.

RESPOND: What are you waiting on right now? Spend time asking God to help you trust him in the gap.

Tuesday

READ: 2 Corinthians 4:16–18

REFLECT: One of the hardest parts of waiting is wondering if God is doing anything at all. Paul reminds us that more is happening than we can see. God often works in unseen ways. Waiting invites us to remember that God is writing a bigger story.

RESPOND: In what areas are you tempted to focus on only what you can see? Take a moment to thank God for working behind the scenes of your circumstances.

Wednesday

READ: James 1:2–4

REFLECT: Most of us want God to change our circumstances, but God also works in us while we wait. James says that trials produce perseverance, and perseverance helps us mature. Waiting grows us and reminds us how much we need God. Many times, our greatest growth happens during seasons we would never choose.

RESPOND: What might God be teaching you during this season? Ask him to help you grow while you wait.

Thursday

READ: Isaiah 40:31

REFLECT: Waiting on the Lord isn't passive. It's a decision to keep trusting when you don't have all the answers. It's choosing to believe God's timing is good even when it doesn't match yours. Isaiah promises that those who wait on the Lord will find renewed strength. God meets us in the waiting and gives us what we need for the next step.

RESPOND: Where do you need renewed strength today? Tell God you're willing to trust his timing.

Friday

READ: 1 Thessalonians 5:11

REFLECT: Waiting can feel lonely. It's easy to assume nobody understands what you're carrying. That's one reason God gave us the church. Sometimes the greatest gift during a waiting season is someone who listens, prays, encourages, and reminds us not to give up. We all need people who help us keep our eyes on God when the waiting gets hard.

RESPOND: Who has encouraged you during a difficult season? Reach out and encourage someone else today.

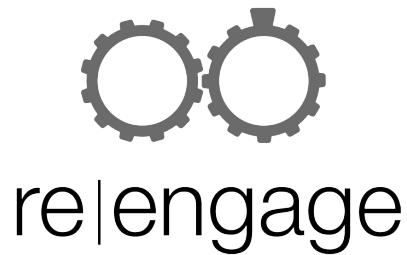
