Unoffendable: What Humans are Like

1 Corinthians 4:3-5; John 2: 24-25

Here's what I want us to consider today: ***What if - the thing that feels most righteous - is what's making us most miserable?***

FIRST, LOWER OUR EXPECTATIONS.

The Apostle Paul reminds us *"For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God."* Romans 3:23,

NEXT, RAISE OUR LEVEL OF GRACE.

THIRD, SURRENDER OUR INTERNAL NARRATIVE.

AND FINALLY, PUT DOWN THE WEIGHT. *UNoffendability is not defeat - it is rest.* Aren't you tired?

REMEMBER: Lower your expectations

Raise your grace

Surrender your narrative

Put down the weight

Little by little, as we practice offering forgiveness and grace, we will find ourselves walking in a deeper freedom. A freedom that helps us begin to look more Christ-like and enjoy an UNOFFENDABLE life!
