## Setting the Tone for the Experience

### What You Say:

#### OPENER

**HOST:** "Hey, everyone! Welcome back to Kingdom Quest! It's summertime, which means new adventures! If this is your first time, welcome—I'm so glad you are here!

"Before we do anything else, let's get moving. Everybody, stand up!

"Turn to someone near you and give them a high-five.

*(Pause while kids high-five each other.)*

"Nice! Now find someone wearing a summer color—blue like the pool, yellow like the sun, or green like the grass—and give them a fist bump.

*(Pause while kids fist bump each other.)*

"Great! Now turn to someone else and tell them one thing you love about summer. Ready? Go!

*(Pause while kids talk to their neighbor.)*

"Awesome! This whole summer, we've been talking about God's kingdom. The name of our series this month is 'Kingdom Quest—Living the Greatest Adventure.'

"What is God's kingdom? Well, it's anywhere that God reigns! It's anywhere where He is seen as King and His good ways are lived out. God is loving, joyful, patient, kind, honest, trustworthy—all of these amazing things. God's kingdom is good because He is so good! We want His good kingdom everywhere. That's the Kingdom Quest we're on—to show off God's good kingdom!

"And since we're on a Kingdom Quest, I have a game for us today that's called ... 'Kingdom Quest Switch!'

*SLIDE: Kingdom Quest Switch! Title*

"In this game, everyone is going to be assigned a quest object: a map, a shield, a compass, or gold.

"Leaders, go ahead and assign everybody their quest object!

*(Leaders assign map, shield, compass, or gold to all the kids.)*

"Alright, everyone know what you are? Great! Go ahead and say your quest object out loud on the count of three. One, two, three!

*(Kids yell out their quest object.)*

"Amazing! Everyone, remember which quest object you are!

"Here's how the game works: When I call out your quest object, you switch spots with someone else who has the same object. Maps switch with maps. Shields with shields. Compasses with compasses. Gold with gold.

"Now listen carefully, because this is an important rule: When I yell 'Kingdom Quest!', everyone switches spots! Every single person in the room moves at the same time.

"It gets loud, it gets fast, and you have to stay sharp. Let's practice a little.

"Map!

*(Pause while kids switch.)*

"Shield!

*(Pause while kids switch.)*

"Compass!

*(Pause while kids switch.)*

"Gold!

*(Pause while kids switch.)*

"Great! Now let's try the big one.

"Kingdom Quest!

*(Pause while the entire room switches places.)*

"Nice! You guys are ready for the real round. Here we go!

*(Play the game. Call out the quest objects quickly to keep the kids moving!)*

*AUDIO: Upbeat music*

"Map!

*(Pause while kids switch.)*

"Shield!

*(Pause while kids switch.)*

"Compass!

*(Pause while kids switch.)*

"Gold!

*(Pause while kids switch.)*

"Map!

*(Pause while kids switch.)*

"Compass!

*(Pause while kids switch.)*

"Kingdom Quest!

*(Pause while kids switch.)*

"And freeze! Amazing work. What a great job! And great listening, everyone!

*(Continue with more rounds as time allows. If you play more rounds, leaders can reassign quest objects to the kids to mix up the game a bit.)*

"That was so much fun! Let's take a look at our Bottom Line for today. It tells us something amazing Jesus wants us to know about God's kingdom.

*SLIDE: Bottom Line*

**[Bottom Line]** "God's kingdom grows when you use what He's given you. Can you say that with me?"

**KIDS AND HOST:** **[Bottom Line]** "God's kingdom grows when you use what He's given you."

**HOST:** "Nice job! Now let's get ready to learn more about God's kingdom together!"

## Inviting People to Respond to God

### What You Say:

#### AMAZING MUSIC

**WORSHIP LEADER:** "Hey, everyone! I'm so glad you're here. Before we sing today, I want to talk for a minute about something really important: worship. Worship isn't just music. It's not just singing loudly or knowing all the motions. Worship is when we turn our attention toward God and say with our hearts, 'You are good. You are King. And I want to follow You.'

"Our first song is called 'Closer.' Let's focus and worship God right now.

*SONG: "Closer" Dance Motion, Lyric or Instrumental Lyric Videos are available with Amazing Music on APlay*

"Our next song reminds us that God is good all the time. He is steady and strong. Even when we feel unsure or when things are changing around us, God stays the same. He is the King of our hearts and King over all creation! Let's praise Him together!

### What You Say:

**SONG:** "King Of My Heart" Dance Motion, Lyric or Instrumental Lyric Videos are available with Amazing Music on APlay

"This week, when you're at the pool, or riding in the car, or sitting at home, you can take a second to talk to God. You can whisper a quick 'Thank You.' You can ask Him for help. You can remember the words you sang today. That's worship too.

"Now it's time to look at our Memory Verse for the month! These are words Paul wrote about God's kingdom. He shared that God's kingdom is full of what's right, peace, and joy. It's full of good stuff because God is good!

"And we don't get those good things in our lives by trying harder ... we get them because they're gifts from the Holy Spirit. As you keep in step with the Spirit, your life will be filled with righteousness, peace, and joy. God's Spirit will grow these good things because He is good!

"Our Memory Verse this month is found in Romans 14:17. I'll read it first, and then I'll lead you through it!

*SLIDE: Memory Verse*

**WORSHIP LEADER:** *"God's kingdom is not about eating or drinking. It is about doing what is right and having peace and joy. All this comes through the Holy Spirit (Romans 14:17 NIV)."*

"Now, let me lead you through it! Repeat after me—nice and loud!

"And here's something simple you can do this week: If you start to feel frustrated, worried, or unsure, stop for a moment, and whisper this verse to yourself. You can even say, 'God, please help me.' God loves to help us! He loves to spread His ways into your heart! It is so good to be a part of God's kingdom because the King is just so good!

"Thanks for worshipping with me today, friends!"

**What You Say:****BIBLE STORY (STORYTELLER SCRIPT)***SLIDE: Theme Background**(Things to have ready: Set up the table at the front of the teaching area so the Storyteller can place their Bible on it and read from it. Three "money bags" and money box on the table.)***INTRODUCTION****STORYTELLER:** "Hi, friends! I'm so glad to see all of your bright, excited faces today! We're going to do my favorite thing today! We're going to learn about God together!"

"All summer long, we've been talking about God's kingdom. Our theme this month is: 'Kingdom Quest—Living the Greatest Adventure.'

"But what is God's kingdom? Well, God's kingdom is where He is King! It's where He reigns, and where His ways—His love, His faithfulness, His truthfulness, and His goodness—are the way things operate. God's kingdom is a good, good place that we want everyone to be a part of! We want more people to see how awesome God, the King, is and join His kingdom!"

"Today, we're going to look at an assignment the King has given everyone in His kingdom until He comes back.

"So, to help us get started with our Bible Story, imagine something with me: Imagine you've been given a very important job. Something that could make a big difference in the world ... something only YOU can do. You've been trusted with a special gift, a responsibility, or a treasure. And it's up to you to decide what you'll do with it. That's a special and big job!"

"How does that feel? Exciting? A little scary? Fun? Maybe all three at the same time?"

"Well, as we'll see in today's story, that imagination is true. God has given you a treasure that no one else has! And He wants you to use this treasure to point to Him and His kingdom until He comes back. Let's listen in on today's story."

**SETTING UP THE STORY****STORYTELLER:** "The story we're learning about today is called a parable, which is a short story Jesus used to help people understand something important about God's kingdom."

"A week before He told this story, Jesus had entered the city of Jerusalem to celebrate Passover. The city was bustling with people

walking through the streets, children running, and merchants calling out from the marketplaces. It was an exciting and busy time.

"Later that week, Jesus led His disciples to a quiet place called the Mount of Olives. From there, they could look out over the city and the hills beyond. There, Jesus taught His friends about God's kingdom and shared stories to help them understand how God's kingdom works.

"One of the stories Jesus told was about a wealthy man who was preparing to go on a very long journey. Before leaving, he called his servants and gave them something very important to take care of while he was gone. Each servant was given different amounts of this special treasure because the master knew that each one could handle different responsibilities."

### **the first two servants**

**STORYTELLER:** "Let's see what the story says.

*(Open the Bible and read Matthew 25:14-15 NIV.)*

*"Again, it will be like a man going on a journey, who called his servants and entrusted his wealth to them. To one he gave five bags of gold, to another two bags, and to another one bag, each according to his ability. Then he went on his journey."*

"Imagine standing there as the master hands out real gold. Each servant looks down at what they've been given. Some hold a lot. Some hold a little. But the master knows them well. He trusts each one to take care of exactly what they can handle.

*(Pick up the first two bags of gold, and hold them up so the audience can see.)*

"These two bags represent the bags of gold the master gave the first two servants. The first two servants didn't stand around wondering what to do. They didn't hide their gold or wait until it felt safe. They got moving and did something with it.

*(Open the Bible and read Matthew 25:16-17 NIV.)*

*"The man who had received five bags of gold went at once and put his money to work and gained five bags more. So also, the one with two bags of gold gained two more."*

"Both servants took what they were given and used it. They tried, they worked, and their gold doubled! They didn't worry about what the others had—they just used what they had.

"Then, the master in the story returned ... and he called his servants again.

*(Open the Bible and read Matthew 25:20-23 NIV.)*

*"The man who had received five bags of gold brought the other five. 'Master,' he said, 'you entrusted me with five bags of gold. See, I have gained five more.'*

*"His master replied, 'Well done, good and faithful servant! You have been faithful with a few things; I will put you in charge of many things. Come and share your master's happiness!'*

*"The man with two bags of gold also came. 'Master,' he said, 'you entrusted me with two bags of gold; see, I have gained two more.'*

*"His master replied, 'Well done, good and faithful servant! You have been faithful with a few things; I will put you in charge of many things. Come and share your master's happiness!'"*

"The master celebrated both servants. He saw how they used what they were given, and he was filled with joy. These bags of gold remind us that when we use what God gives us, every single little thing, it can grow in amazing ways."

### **The third servant**

**STORYTELLER:** "Now Jesus explained what happened with the third servant.

*(Pick up the third bag of gold, and hold it up so the audience can see.)*

*(Open the Bible and read Matthew 25:18 NIV.)*

*"But the man who had received one bag went off, dug a hole in the ground and hid his master's money in it."*

"This man made a different choice. Instead of trying, instead of using his gift, he buried it. It would be like taking the gold ... and doing this.

*(Place the third bag of gold in the money box.)*

"Once it's hidden away, no one can see it. No one can use it. It can't grow. It just sits there in the dark.

*(Open the Bible and read Matthew 25:24-25 NIV.)*

*"Then the man who had received one bag of gold came. 'Master,' he said, 'I knew that you are a hard man, harvesting where you have not sown and gathering where you have not scattered seed. So I was afraid and went out and hid your gold in the ground. See, here is what belongs to you.'"*

*(Hold up the money box so the audience can see, and lock it.)*

"The man admitted he was afraid. Fear kept him from even trying. He didn't take a chance. He didn't trust his master. He hid what he was given, like the gold locked inside this box—unable to help anyone and unable to grow.

"Let's see what the master had to say to this servant.

*(Open the Bible and read Matthew 25:26-28 NIV.)*

*"His master replied, 'You wicked, lazy servant! So you knew that I harvest where I have not sown and gather where I have not scattered seed? Well then, you should have put my money on deposit with the bankers, so that when I returned I would have received it back with interest.*

*'So take the bag of gold from him and give it to the one who has ten bags.'"*

"The master wasn't upset that the servant had only one bag. He was upset because the servant didn't use what he had been given. The master knew this servant was capable of doing something. But instead of trusting the master and using his gift, the servant hid it away.

"Jesus told this part of the story so we would understand something important: God doesn't want us to hide the things He gives us. He wants us to trust Him. He wants us to use our gifts, our time, our kindness, our abilities—even when we feel unsure. Because when we use the things God has given us, He can grow something amazing for His kingdom."

### wrapping up THE STORY

**STORYTELLER:** "This parable Jesus told had a clear message for the people listening. The master gave each servant something valuable to take care of while he was away. Two of the servants used what they were given, and what they had grew. But the third servant hid what he had because he was afraid. All three were trusted with gold, but each one chose to do something different with it.

"The first two servants showed courage and responsibility. They took what the master gave them and put it to work. But the third servant chose to hide what he was given, and nothing changed or grew.

"Jesus told this story to show what life in God's kingdom is like. God gives His people real things to take care of while He is gone. Jesus, our Master, is in heaven now, but He's coming back! And when He comes back, He's going to live with us forever. But in the meantime, He invites us to use every single thing He has given us to do things that make Him happy—just like the first two servants did. They loved their master, and so they used whatever the master gave them to make him happy. They grew and grew what their master had given them. God will do the same thing with the gifts He has given you! God will do great kingdom things with the gifts He has given you when you use them!

"That reminds me of our Bottom Line for today. Let's check it out.

*SLIDE: Bottom Line*

**[Bottom Line] "God's kingdom grows when you use what He's given you. Can you say that with me?"**

*(Host enters and joins in.)*

**KIDS, STORYTELLER, AND HOST: [Bottom Line] "God's kingdom grows when you use what He's given you."**

## WHAT'S OUR PART IN THE STORY?

## Prompting Action Beyond the Experience

### What You Say:

#### WHAT'S OUR PART IN THE STORY?

**HOST:** "This is the part Jesus wants us to understand: God doesn't want what He gives us to stay locked away. He doesn't want our gifts, our talents, our kindness, or our chances to help others to stay hidden. When we bring those things out, when we actually use what God has placed in our hands, His kingdom grows.

*(Unlock the money box, and take out the third bag of gold.)*

"I encourage you not to hide what God has given you. Use every single thing you have in a way you know would make Him happy. But don't do good things with your gifts to try to earn God's love. God already loves you—so much so that Jesus paid for your sins!

"But do use every last thing God has given you—not to try to earn His love, but to make Him happy. Maybe He has put you on the swim team this summer. You can ask, 'Okay, Jesus, how can I use this time on the team to make You happy?' Maybe you can encourage a teammate who isn't really very good at backstroke. Maybe swimming is really hard for you, and you show faithfulness by trying again. Maybe if you're really good and win all the time, you can be humble even though you're so fast!

"Or maybe you really like to bake, and when you look in the pantry, you find all the ingredients to bake cookies. You can ask yourself, 'How can I make Jesus happy with those ingredients and my baking skills?' Maybe bake some cookies and share them with a lonely neighbor. Or share them with your brother or sister, who is really hard to get along with sometimes.

"Think of every single thing you have and ask: 'How can I make God smile with this?' He's given you great things, and you can use them well until He gets back!

"Because just like the master in the story, Jesus, our wise master who left us with so many gifts, is coming back. He wants to see what we've done with all the gifts He's given us. That might sound scary, but you never have to be afraid, because God loves you, He is always with you, and He wants to see you do great things with what He's given you. God will help you use your gifts to do great kingdom things! Ask Him to help you think of things to do if you need it!

"Let's take a quiet moment to talk to the good master who left us with gifts."

- Confirm that your church has appropriate licensing to perform or play music and sound effects in your kids' environments (see above under Opener).

- Place the three money bags and the money box on the table for the Storyteller to use during the teaching.
