Wilson Area Hymn Festival!

This past June, Tim Surles and I traveled to Wilson to take part in a Hymn Festival sponsored by the Greater Wilson Area Church Musicians Guild. The guild is made up of around 10 church musicians from the greater Wilson area. This was our 5th Hymn Festival, a project that was born out of the COVID-19 pandemic as a way to bring people together for music and worship after spending time apart. Each year the hymn festival has grown in some unique way. The first year was just choir, piano and organ, the second year added instruments, last year we were led by a clinician, and this year we added a children's element to the service. The festival is always a unique time to gather with different people across several different denominations for a collective goal, to make music and worship together.

This year's theme was Water-River-Spirit-Grace. We used a repeated theme chorus through the service as a way to connect the four main sections. Each section included the theme chorus, a hymn set, and a musical selection either from the choir or orchestra. The directors took turns leading the different sets. For example, I led the first set...WATER. We sang the theme chorus, then I led the congregation in singing "Come, Though Fount of Every Blessing" and "Guide Me, O Thou Great Jehovah". Then I led the choir in singing an anthem titled, "Come to the Water", arranged by Jack Schrader. Some of the other sets included hymns like, "Sweet, Sweet Spirit", "Like a River Glorious", "Wonderful Grace of Jesus", and more. In total we sang 10+ hymns, the orchestra played three pieces, and the choir/men's ensemble sang five pieces. There were 40+ singers in the choir, and 25+ players in the orchestra representing 10+ churches in the area. I did not get an official count, but I would assume there were around 200+ people in attendance. I would like to add a special thank you to those in our congregation who attended both in person and online. Plus, a special thank you to NBC for supporting local music and worship opportunities in our area.
