

Lazarus of Bethany, brother of Mary and Martha, became sick, and the sisters sent word to Jesus: “Lord, the one you love is sick.” Though he loved them, Jesus delayed, saying the sickness would reveal God’s glory.

By the time Jesus arrived, Lazarus had been in the tomb four days. Martha met him, grieving, “Lord, if you had been here, my brother would not have died.” Jesus told her, “Your brother will rise again... I am the resurrection and the life. The one who believes in me will live, even though they die.” Martha affirmed her faith.

Mary came weeping, and seeing her grief, Jesus was deeply moved. He asked to be taken to the tomb—and there, Jesus wept.

At the tomb, Jesus said, “Take away the stone.” After praying, he called out, “Lazarus, come out!” And Lazarus emerged, still wrapped in burial cloths. Jesus said, “Unbind him, and let him go.”

Many who witnessed this believed in him.
