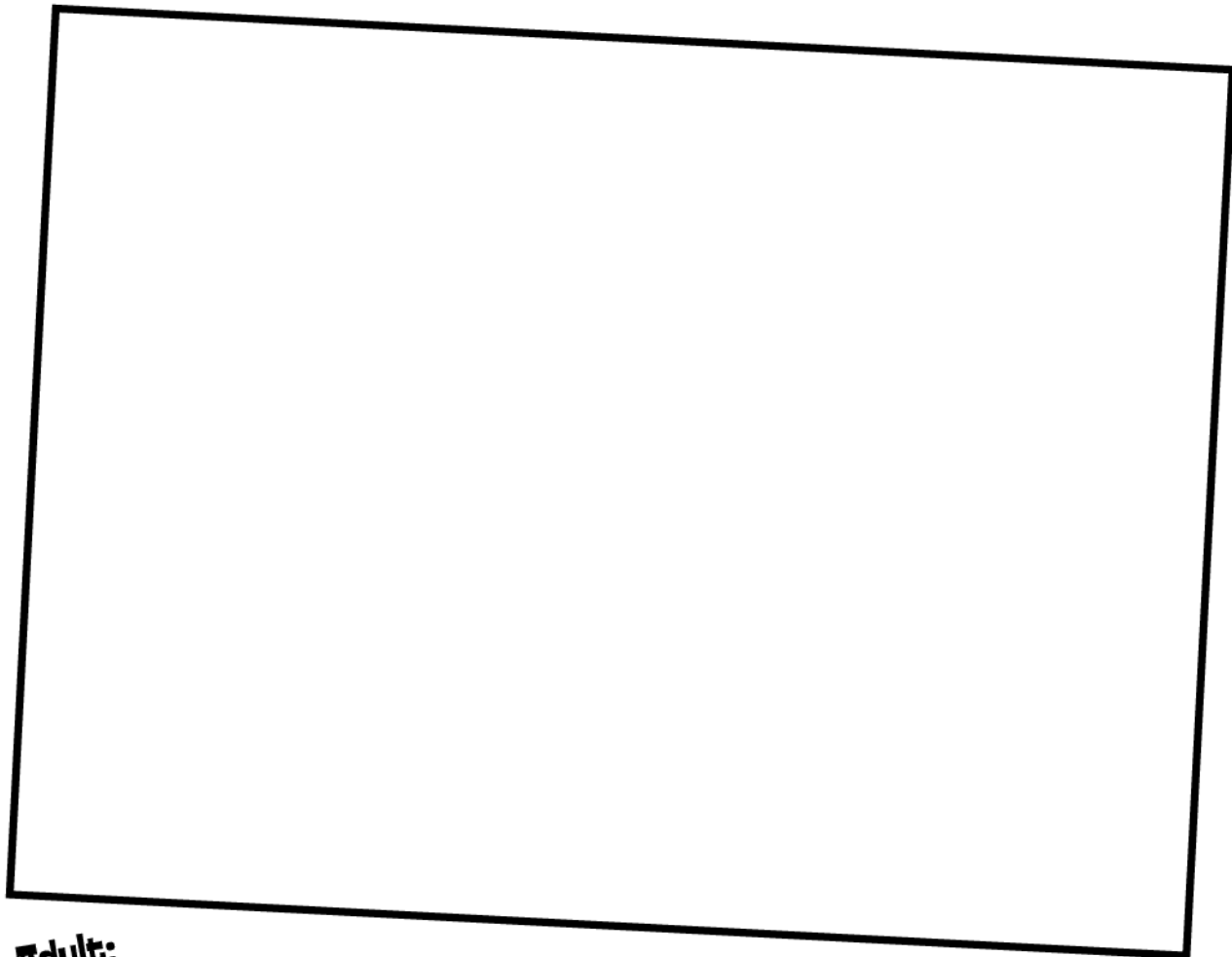
Adult:

Adult:

How is your adult's drawing different than yours? Find where that happened in the story.

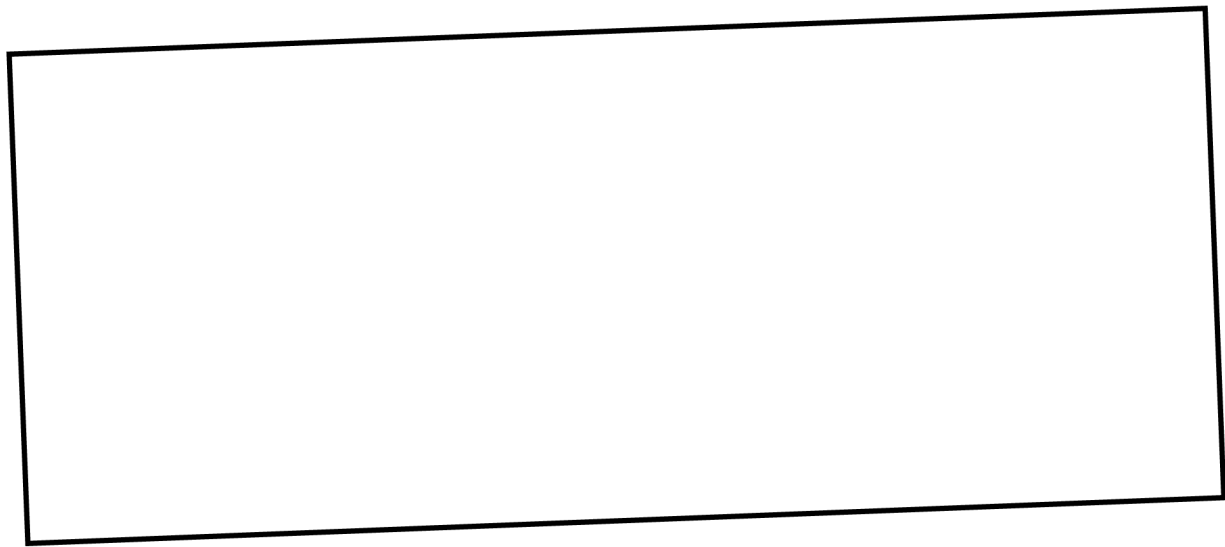
KINDI - 1ST Day 3
