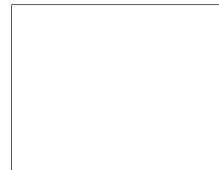

Mary Magdalene who first discovered the empty tomb was overcome with grief. Not only did she believe Jesus had died but that someone had stolen His body. And to all the disciples who had been broken by shame and guilt - especially Peter who had denied him - the risen Christ forgave them, restored their confidence and sent them out to fulfill a great mission. You see, we can celebrate Easter every day because Jesus is present with us to comfort, strengthen, and encourage us and to meet our needs. So may every day be a celebration of His loving presence with us!
