SUNDAY MORNING SUPPORT:

If you are interested in helping on Sunday mornings in any of the following ways, sign up in the foyer or contact the front office at 907-376-2176.

Greeters: Welcome our family of faith and our guests either by opening a door or meeting them inside the foyer with a bulletin. Direct newcomers to the Welcome Desk and/or CoffeeHouse.

CoffeeHouse Service: Prepare coffee (tea, hot chocolate, etc.) before each service. We have a standard setup. Simply learn the routine and look for uncovered Sundays in the CoffeeHouse on the sign-up board. Great opportunity for a couple!

Ushers: Greet folks as they enter the sanctuary and offer them seating. This is a helpful service as the room fills up. Men and women of high-school age and above are welcome to usher.

Offering Collection & Counting: Five people are needed for each service to pass and receive the offering baskets. A team of at least two (unrelated) people are needed to count the offering after the 2nd service.

Welcome Desk: This team covers the Welcome Desk area before, in between, and after services. We help newcomers feel welcomed, direct people to resources, and answer questions.

Sunday Chair Set-up: Each Sunday at 7:30am a team of at least four are needed to set up all the chairs in the sanctuary. There is an efficient system to this, and it takes about 30 minutes to get all our chairs up.

Widow Care+ Team: Volunteers seek to maintain relational connections with the widows among us through phone calls, visits, and personal notes/cards.
