Ash Wednesday: *Marked for Love, Sent for Service*

“Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return.”

Pick up and bring home this **Lenten Action Card**.

Pray for the journey ahead.

First Sunday in Lent: *Hunger in Our Midst*

“Give us this day our daily bread.”

Donate these **protein-rich** foods:

- > peanut butter
- > canned chicken
- > protein bars

Pray before meals for our neighbors who are hungry and don't have enough.

Second Sunday in Lent: *Warming Christ's Body*

“I was a stranger and you welcomed me.”

Donate these **cold-weather** items:

- > white tube/crew socks
- > gloves & hand-warmers
- > hats

Remember our neighbors facing cold nights.

Third Sunday in Lent: *Water, Cleanliness, Dignity*

“Those who drink of the water I give will never be thirsty.”

Donate any of these **toiletries**:

- > toothpaste & toothbrushes
- > feminine hygiene products
- > case of bottled water

Thank God for clean water and daily care.

Fourth Sunday in Lent: *Light in the Darkness*

“Once you were darkness, but now you are light in the Lord.”

Write a **card or a letter of encouragement** for our congregation members who are homebound or in a care facility.
(Card-writing stations will be available after and between services.)

Pray for those who feel forgotten or alone.

Fifth Sunday in Lent: *Repairing what is Broken*

“See, I am making all things new.”

Donate any of these **cleaning supplies**:

- > all-purpose cleaner
- > microfiber cloths
- > dish soap

Help a neighbor with light repair or spring care projects.

Holy Week: *Love Poured Out*

“You are marked with the cross of Christ forever – and sent into the world in love.”

Please bring in any remaining items that have been requested throughout our lenten journey.

Pray for those who will receive these gifts. **Give thanks** for Christ's love poured out for the world.
